(king) (book) (holiness)
Nouns of the type מֶלֶךְ סֵפֶר קֹדֶשׁ are evolved from the originals
[מֶלֶךְ] [סֵפֶר] [קֹדֶשׁ]^a which, in the first stage, received
the vowel Seghol [מֶלֶךְ] [סֵפֶר] [קֹדֶשׁ]^b and by a further step, these forms
became מֶלֶךְ סֵפֶר קֹדֶשׁ —the classical forms.
